

Quick guide to help you respond to the Public Consultation for North Northants Local Nature Recovery Strategy

It is really important that as many people as possible do respond - even if it's just to say that it's great and you thoroughly agree with everything. Responses can be anonymous

1. Download or read online the big main document.

- Go to https://www.northnorthants.gov.uk/conservation-and-protection/local-nature-recovery-strategy
- Scroll right down to Documents
- Download "Local Nature Recovery Strategy for consultation" it's a big document!
- Have a quick scroll through. Note: Content is on page 5 and How to use this document on page 6

2. Return to council website and scroll to Document section.

• Watch the helpful short video.

3. Return to big document

- Skim read pages 7, 8, 9, 10, 11
- Read more and make notes on areas of particular interest to you

4. Start your response

- Go to https://northnorthants.citizenspace.com/place-and-economy/lnrs/consultation/subpage.2024-10-14.6577701337/
- Look through the survey. There are 8 pages. Scroll through using Continue and Back
- Start to enter stuff on page 1. You are not required to enter your name and can change anything later
- Press "Save and come back later" and when prompted enter your email address. (You don't need to press this button after every page)
- You will receive an email which will give to a link to come back to your response at any time (Every time you press the "Save and come back later" button you are sent a new email -don't worry!)

5. Continue your response

- Use your emailed link to pick up where you left off
- You don't have to answer all the questions.
- Many questions are Strongly agree, Agree etc. If in doubt we suggest you use one of these first two
- Questions 4,6,7,8, 11, 13 allow you to type a qualified answer, if you wish E.g in Q7 you can add suggestions such as:
 - "049 add Grey Squirrel or include as an extra Practical Action"
- After every session spent making changes don't forget to Save

6. Submit your completed response before December 9th

• Responses can be sent anonymously or not. If you wish you could include your name or the group your represent on any of the open questions – even in the box at the bottom of page 1.
